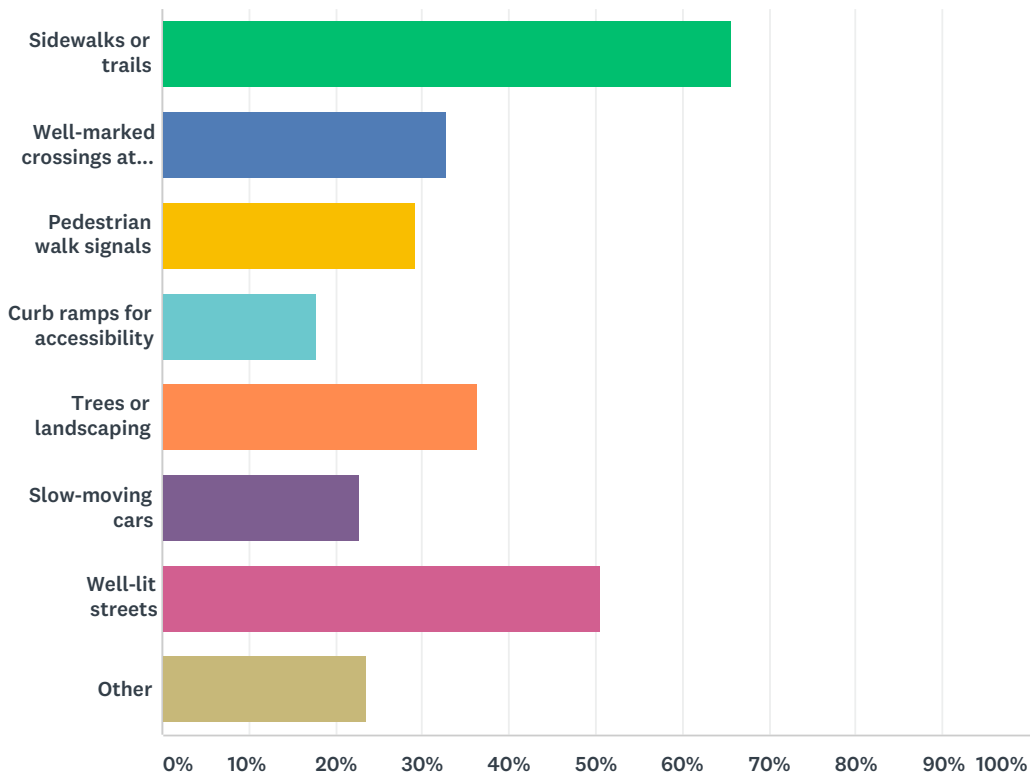


Q1 Walking in the Casper Area would be better if there were more... (select all that apply)

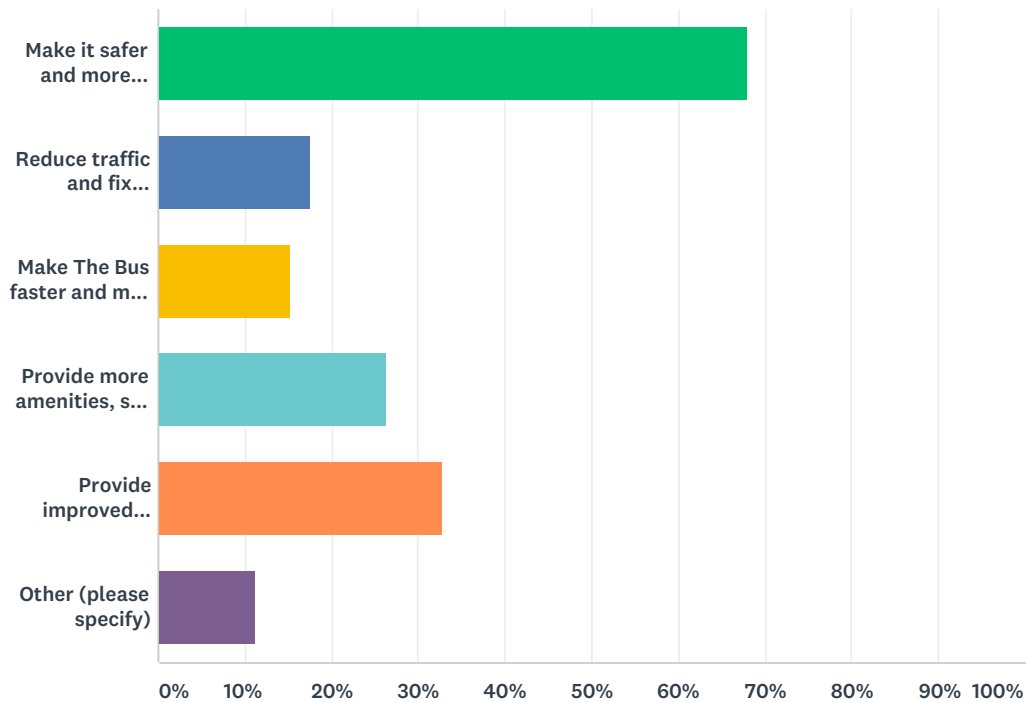

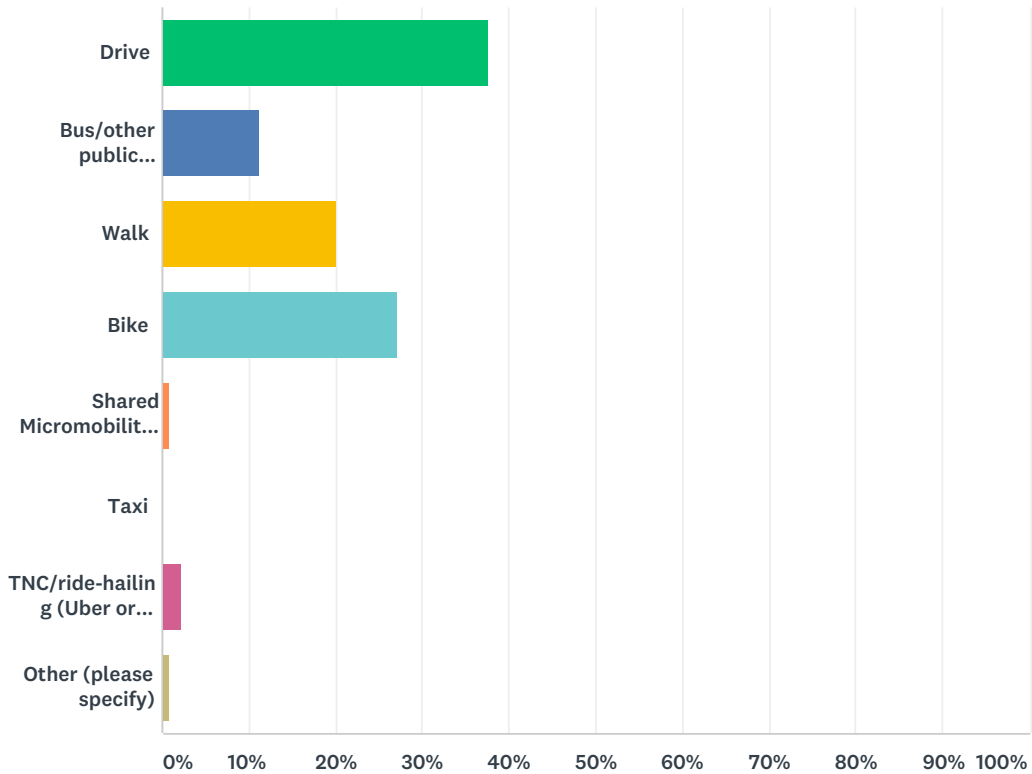

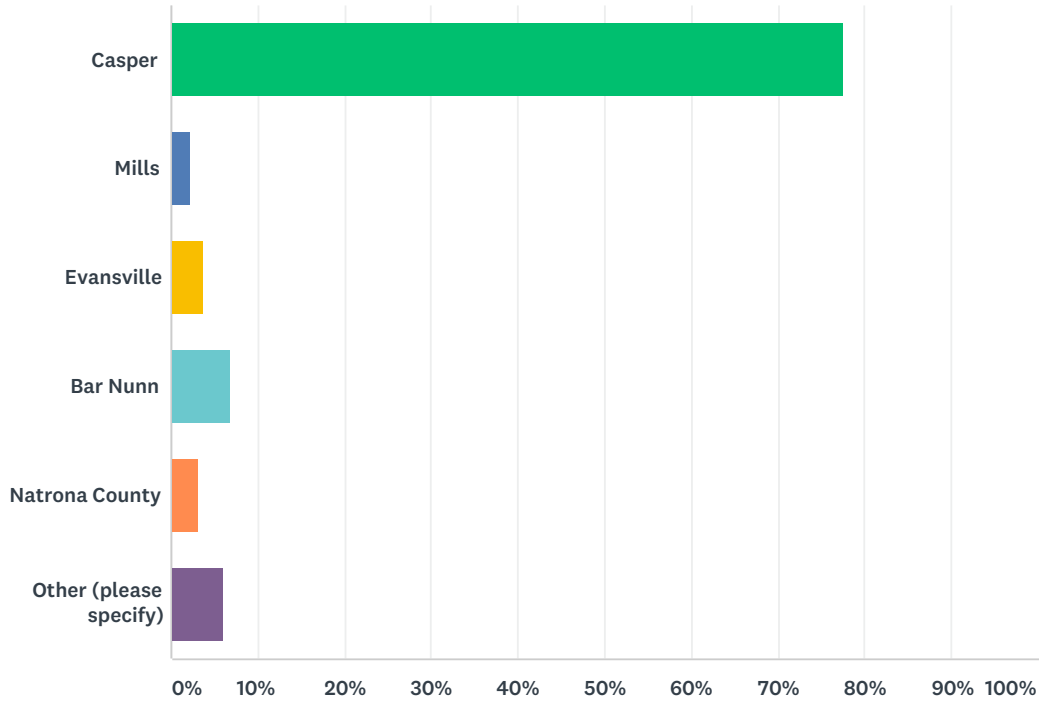
